

<b>Name of market/timing</b>	Burnham-on-Sea Farmers' Market Last Friday of each month (9am - 1pm or possibly 2pm in the summer)
<b>Address and postcode</b>	High Street, Burnham-on-Sea, Somerset, TA8 1PB

<b>Indoor/outdoor</b>	Outdoor canopy market
<b>Table provided/needed and space available</b>	Own table needed – approx. 2.5m frontage sharing a 3m x 3.5m canopy
<b>Electricity</b>	Electricity available (£2). Own extension lead needed. Equipment must be PAT tested.
<b>Parking information and costs</b>	Nearby pay and display car park, currently £2.50 (9am – 1pm). Some free on street parking a bit further away.
<b>Toilet information</b>	Toilets in car park and on sea front (about ½ mile).
<b>Best place for a coffee</b>	A dozen or more local cafes within a 50m radius.
<b>Any other useful information about the market for a new trader</b>	<p>Unloading and loading can be a bit of a problem as access is cramped but OK with patience.</p> <p>Often windy in Burnham – bring clamps for cloths and weights for leaflets and other light things. Also often chilly, even on a nice day, particularly at the start – bring something warm.</p> <p>High footfall as in the High Street but a lot of people tend to walk straight past – make your stall as eye-catching as possible.</p> <p>Friday market so main customer base is part elderly, part holiday makers/day visitors. Relatively few ‘family shoppers’ compared to a Saturday market.</p>
<b>Costs</b>	£23 on the day and on invoice (£5 discount for veg/plants)
